This UNF renovation of Roy Lassiter Hall's second floor will provide a modern, healthy and efficient learning environment. The facility was first built in 1974 and has had minimal improvements. Project will better utilize the existing space and provide a more current learning environment. Currently, classroom instructional techniques are limited by the outdated technology and the space is not conducive for collaboration. The condition of the space is such that the students and faculty believe there are health and safety issues. The HVAC system is 16 years old and requires replacement in order to meet current ventilation requirements and to improve building efficiency.
