4. Project/Program Description:

The purpose of this funding request is to continue to take septic tanks off-line and connect customers to the City of Ocala's sanitary sewer system. This funding would take 200 septic tanks off-line, reducing total Nitrogen in groundwater by an estimated 2,868 lbs annually. This funding would assist in covering: septic tank abandonment, lateral to sewer main, impact fees, and yard restoration.

#### 11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The primary objective of the project is to design and construct a sanitary sewer system which will remove from service approximately 200 septic tanks. This will reduce nutrient loading in the Silver Springs Basin. Silver Springs is an impaired water body due to nutrient pollution.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The work covers the cost of connection, septic tank abandonment, lawn restoration and impact fees associated with the connection. Residents would be able to connect to the sanitary sewer at no cost. By taking septic tanks off-line and connecting residents to the sanitary sewer this would improve the water quality of impaired water bodies such as the Silver Springs spring shed.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

The resident would receive, free of charge to them, cost of connection, septic tank abandonment, lawn restoration, and impact fees associated with the connection.

- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
  - Residents within City of Ocala limits, that currently have a septic tank and have availability to city sewer. There is currently a database of interested residents.
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The estimated domestic wastewater is based on the Bureau of Onsite Sewage Programs estimates. This total estimated reduction is based on data that the loadings in pounds of nitrogen per OSTDS in the Silver Springs Springshed is approximately 9.92 lb-N/person, and the household average in Marion County is 2.41 persons.
