4. **Project/Program Description**

The City's current water pumping facility is 30+ years old and not optimally located to provide the needed pressures in the northeast portion of the City. The northeast part of the City has seen and will continue to see substantial economic growth including housing developments and commercial developments. The City also has an industrial area in the northeast portion of the City and future industrial economic development may be limited due to inadequate fire flow capacity. The City is going to build a new Booster Pump Station Facility to improve pressure for peak demand and also provide the needed fire flow. Also included in this project will be improvements to the chemical system to maintain chlorine residuals in the area, install pressure sensors to monitor performance in the system and also an construct an emergency interconnect with Sarasota County which will supply water to the City if for any reason the City's water supply is interrupted due to an emergency.

The new Booster Pump Station would allow the needed water pressures and fire flow to the northeast portion of the City. The project will also have improvements to the chemical system and install pressure sensors to monitor the performance in the system and also construct an emergency interconnect so that water will be supplied to the City if for any reason the City's water supply is interrupted due to an emergency.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The purpose of the funds is to assist in funding the construction of the New Booster Pump Station and also to make improvements to the chemical system and install pressure sensors to monitor the performance of the system along with constructing an emergency interconnect.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The citizens will have needed pressures especially during peak demand and will have the needed fire flow which is critical if for any reason there is a fire. Also the emergency interconnect benefits the entire City for any reason there is an interruption to the City's supply the City will have access to the County's supply via the interconnect.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project targets the entire City's population which is 23,315 as of April 2019.

Service line pressure and chlorine residuals are monitored in the affected area to ensure compliance with standards.
