This corridor plays a crucial role in the City's transportation network, moving tens of thousands on a daily basis. 63rd Street is a congestion point in the Miami Beach transportation network. The proposed enhancement of 63 will include bicycle lanes, bicycle boxes, space for transit, improved traffic flow, enhanced sidewalks, a new connection to the be Allison Park, and a designated freight loading area.
