a.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?				
	The goal of this project is to eliminate barriers to access for residents as they walk or bike throughout the village. The project creates a safe route to school for children attending Treasure Island Elementary School.				
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?				
	The village will fill in sidewalk gaps, eliminate trip hazards, install ADA compliant crosswalks and ramps, and improved pedestrian signage.				
c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?				
	The project promotes use of alternative transit (walking, biking, public scooters, etc.) for short trips. Residents will also have increased access to recreation and connections to the state bike trail.				
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?				
	This is a public facility, accessible to all residents and visitors of North Bay Village, and the project improves the aesthetics and accessibility for people living in or visiting the Treasure Island community. It is expected to serve over 1,000 unduplicated residents annually.				
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?				
	The expected outcome is to improve walkability in North Bay Village. Methodology will include the amount of sidewalk gaps filled and ADA facilities installed. A post-project walkability audit will be conducted to ensure success of the project.
