- c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The project will remove flood waters from roadways in the heavily travelled area of Southwest Ranches. It will provide critical drainage capacity for storm-water runoff, thereby reducing roadway flooding and the frequency of property damage and personal injury to motorists and pedestrians.

- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project goal is to alleviate flood staging and routing. The execution of these respective projects will provide flood relief to all of our constituents.

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The Town of Southwest Ranches and South Broward Drainage District have long established the need to improve water quality and combat eutrophication in the S9 and S-10 basins. These respective basins are sampled regularly by SBDD and the Town has partnered with SBDD to try and continually improve the readings displaying nutrient loading with respect to total nitrogen and total phosphorous. The purpose of this project is multi-faceted, with one objective set to reduce stormwater staging in the basins and the other to significantly increase water quality in the S9 and S10 basins.
