This project will enhance the quality of life of residents and visitors through arts and culture programming at the facility. The McTyre Park Cultural Center will provide job creation, youth engagement, senior programming, social entertainment and thought stimulation. These programs will complement the current list of events (Goombay Festival, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Day Parade, children's performances, holiday toy drive, senior programming, after school programming, summer camp, Mothers' Day, Fathers' Day, and much more).

Once the city selects a vendor to preform the scope of services, a series of meetings will occur to establish time line, objectives, etc. If the selected vendor does not meet the given objectives, the city would then issue a warning.
