The City of Lauderdale Lakes owns 11 miles of canals directly connected to one of the waterways owned by the South Florida Water management District (The C-13 Canal). Discharge to the C-13 canal is currently done without any treatment or control. the City's hydraulic capacity and flood control protection level depends directly on the conditions of the C-13 canal. With many neighboring cities also discharging to the canal and the high tides for rising sea level, risk of flooding within the City has increased considerably. This project will include the installation of a new drainage system, upgrade of the existing drainage system and flood control measures at all existing outfalls to the C-13 canal.

The implementation of this project will reduce the direct risk of land overflow of the stormwater runoff without any pre-treatment. The surface water quality will be improved as the proposed system will provide pre-treatment to the stormwater runoff before discharging into the C-13 canal. Environmental benefits will be achieved by improving water quality at the C-13. The project will alleviate ponding in the streets, thus improve public safety and reduce road maintenance costs. Streets and properties will also be protected from flooding.

Installation of new drainage system, upgrade of the existing drainage system and flood control measures at all existing outfalls to the C-13 canal.
