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11. Program Performance

What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The completed construction of a third courtroom in the Yulee Annex, would accommodate the county's growing population and resulting increase in civil, criminal and domestic relations court filings. Because of the Legislative Mandate in House Bill 337 last year,

	to raise the jurisdictional limits for civil cases in county court, there is a very real possibility that Nassau County will require another court judge in the near future. Nassau County is stated to be the 9th fastest growing county in the State. with a population growth increasing by 23%. The project will give the county's Judicial operations much needed additional space.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Construction of approximately 2,872 square feet of interior courtroom space. The project will finish the interior of the third courtroom in a manner identical to the other two courtrooms in the Yulee Courthouse Annex.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	This project will assist Nassau County in providing efficient and effective judicial services to the residents as the county prepares for the looming growth in population related to current and future residential development projects. It is estimated that within the next 25 years the population will increase 71%.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	85,000 citizens living within Nassau County and the municipal service area of the region is more than One Million people.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	The expected benefit would be to provide additional courtroom space to accommodate the increased number of filings, because of the Legislative Mandate, for county court. Giving space to add another county court Judge, which would then give Nassau County three courtrooms for five judicial officers that require daily courtroom space. The outcome will be measured by the data supplied by the Nassau County Clerk's office showing the number of filings for the past four fiscal years.
f.	What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?
	Failure to meet deliverables or performance measures would result in the cancellation of the project contract and forfeiture of

remaining balance of unspent Appropriation.
