a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose is to construct the first ever park, recreation, and multipurpose complex in Gadsden County. The goals are: - Enrich Cultural experiences through organized cultural expositions in the multipurpose rooms. - Enhance, preserve, improve environmental, fish, and wildlife quality of sensitive wetlands. - Increase or improve local economic growth through organized competitive sporting events and their multiplier effects. - Increase tourism through organized competitive sporting activities. - Job creation through staffing for recreational and sporting events. - Diversion from criminal and juvenile justice system through organized sporting and social activities providing outlets for the citizens in the community.

- b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
 - Park and recreational sporting activities.
 - Indoor basketball and outdoor sporting activities for adults and youth in the community.
 - Health, fitness and wellness activities for the citizens.
 - Natural disaster shelter that includes accommodations for special services.
 - Venues for community meetings and events.
 - After school computing and tutorial access for the citizens.
- c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
 - Provide park and recreational sporting activities. Provide indoor basketball and outdoor sporting activities for adults and youth in the community. Provide access to health, fitness, and wellness activities for the citizens. Serve as disaster shelter that includes accommodations for special services. Provide venues for community meetings events. Provide after school computing and tutorial access for the citizens.
- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The entire Gadsden County population will have access and will be served by this project. Approximately 87% of the 46,000 Gadsden County population is expected to be served by this project

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
 - Improvements in the county's Robert Wood Foundation Health Ranking (Physical Health and Mental Health). Reduction in the criminal and juvenile delinquent activities through access to social and sporting activities as determined by the Gadsden County Sheriff's Office. Increased small business entrepreneurial opportunities for residents as determined by the Gadsden County Chambers of Commerce and the Gadsden County Development Council.
