### 4. **Project/Program Description**

This project seeks to expand the City of Margate's use of License Plate Reader (LPR) technology to combat auto theft and to enhance investigative capabilities. Currently the Police Department has four (4) mounted LPRs on police vehicles and two (2) LPRs on mobile trailers that can be placed in different areas in the City. The goal is to expand this LPR technology to cover major ingresses or egresses of the City by installing LPRs on fixed points at these locations. Currently, property crimes in the City of Margate are up significantly. Year-to-date statistics show a one hundred percent (100%) increase in business burglary, twenty-two percent (22%) increase in motor vehicle theft, and a three percent (3%) increase in theft from a motor vehicle or conveyance. According to research conducted by RAND Corporation Safety and Justice Program, agencies using this technology have shown statistical increases in cases cleared & arrests made in jurisdictions that have enhanced LPR capabilities.
