11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project is part of an ongoing utility infrastructure phased plan developed in 2016 by Freeport and has been Freeport's top priority project. This project will provide water and sewer capacity along U.S. 331 South from Riverwalk Blvd. to County Road 3280 (segments 3 & 4 on attached plan) to support all current and future water and sewer utility demands and provide the opportunity for development, job creation, and the creation of tax and utility revenues for the City and Walton County.

b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Design and construction of water and sewer mains utilities and lift stations.
c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Improved water pressure and availability as well as sewer capacity for existing development and property owners looking to develop where water and sewer utilities are currently unavailable
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	All users in City of Freeport utility franchise area, residents and property owners in Walton County as well as visitors; greater than 8,000 people
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	Increased and improved economic activity would be measured by new commercial and residential development, new mixed use developments and new industry being created due to additional capacity being provided and the ability for the City of expand its services beyond what is existing. The success of economic activity would be measured by population, commercial and industrial growth, as well as increased revenue for the City. Increased tourism would be measured by the City being an end destination for travelers. This success would be measured by an increase in services, such as food, lodging and retail facilities, as well as recreational businesses. After design and permitting activities are completed, immediate job creation would be provided by the construction of this project. The construction project would provide immediate job opportunities for the entire area due to the project requiring utility crews, and various types of construction crews to complete the project.
f.	What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

The City will award the contract through a bid process. The bid documents will spell out liquidated damage costs for project overruns. The bid documents will also require the selected contractor to provide performance and payment bonds to the City and a 10% retainer will be withheld until all issues are corrected.
