a.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?
	Phase 2 construction of the City of Stuart's Alternative Water Supply project. The City currently treats raw water from the surficial aquifer system (SAS), which is threatened with pollution from various sources including local runoff, saltwater intrusion, and manmade synthetic and organic chemicals and compounds from historical industries. Much of this pollution is out of the scope of control of the City and would be impractical to mitigate directly.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Limit general public from exposure of PFOA and PFOS over certain levels. which over a long time, may result in adverse health effects, improve groundwater quality by reducing potential for saltwater intrusion, and Improve drinking water quality by limiting exposure to groundwater contamination.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	A safe reliable source of drinking water.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	Target population is city residents, business owners and visitors. Current population of approximately 17,000.

	A safe reliable source of drinking water. Monitoring and testing of drinking supply.
