What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Redevelop the facility that houses essential municipal and county emergency services above base flood elevation while providing the

	elevation.  The proposed project is an integral component of downtown redevelopment projects currently underway, such as the Crystal River Linear Park, Town Square Center, and a significant amount of private redevelopment.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	A new Crystal River Government Complex will assure uninterrupted municipal services including, law enforcement, utility services, refuse collection, development services, zoning, elections, parks and recreation, and public works. These services are often interrupted preceding a storm event that necessitates the evacuation of City Hall and relocation of building contents and historic files.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Citizens will be able to have a one-stop shop for all municipal services including law enforcement, utility services, refuse collection, development services, zoning, elections, parks and recreation, public works, and the Three Sisters Springs Visitors Center.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	General public (the majority of funds will benefit no specific group).
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	Protect the general public from harm (environmental, criminal, etc.) - Documentation of the number of flood events and evacuations of City Hall.  Increase or improve economic activity - Increased number of business tax receipts and property values within the community.  Increase tourism - Increased numbers of visitors to Three Sisters Springs and increased overnight stays.  Create specific immediate job opportunities - Creation of temporary construction jobs.  Improve stormwater management - Immediate reduction in the amount of nitrates and other pollutants discharging to Kings Bay.
