11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To aid the council in updating the strategic plan and established goals as required by the strategic plan adopted pursuant to s. 1004.015, F.S. The council's purpose is to continue to develop the strategic plan in order to advance post-secondary education and certifications to match with the hiring needs for Floridians going forward and to meet the statutory goal for a majority of Floridians to have a high-value postsecondary credential by 2030.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Council meetings, including 4 throughout the state, with resources for council members to attend and presenters to provide information; and outside services to better aid the council to update the strategic plan to assist the state to exceed the objectives of statutory goals.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Creation of more and better paying jobs for Floridians as the world becomes more demanding to change for individuals

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All Floridians. Florida graduates 200,000 high school seniors, and the current working population between 25 and 64 years of age ("working-age adults") is estimated to be over 10 million.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The statutory objective is to use strategic planning, data accumulation, and enhanced government communication to raise the percentage of working-age adults with post-secondary and certifications from 49.3% of to over 60% by 2030.
