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	Program Performance
а.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested? Coding - A Priority for our Children's Future, will be a seamless transition program to implement a scaffolding approach to programming. The pilot program will align with our feeder system for Elementary through Middle, through High Schools in the North, Central, and South schools in our district; (5) Elementary Schools, (5) Middle Schools, (3) High Schools. Implementation for the remaining schools will be carried out in future phases.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	This project will teach computer programming to elementary, middle and high school students in order to prepare them to go directly into the local workforce using Apple products. The Coding Project will train teachers to enhance the culture of learning. Using Apps designed for the specific age level, students will learn through challenging, hands-on applications.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Florida currently has 17,695 open computing jobs. The average salary for a computing occupation in FL is \$80,276, which is significantly higher than the average salary in the state (\$44,790). Florida had only 2,986 computer science graduates in 2017; only 18% were female.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	Elementary, middle and high school school students are the targeted population at 13 schools schools. Approximately 350 students will be served by this project.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	Achievement of at least 25% pass rate for the industry certification for students following the track to completion in High School. CAPE Industry Certifications achieved will fund the sustainability of the program. Industry Certification: Apple App Development with Swift Certification Level 1.
