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1.	Program Performance
а.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?
	The primary runway at the DeFuniak Springs Municipal Airport, Runway 9-27, is currently 4,146 feet in length and 60 feet in width, which is insufficient to accommodate larger business jets as well as attract aerospace industries.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	The DeFuniak Springs Airport runway widening and extension will continue to provide support for several commercial businesses located at the airport. The strategic effort to attract commercial businesses in the aerospace, defense, and aviation industries will provide added value and diversity to the Walton County and DeFuniak Springs jobs markets.
c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	The airport expansion would create a favorable business environment for aviation, aerospace, and defense, as well as help transportation trade industries to succeed in the mission of enhancing Florida's economy. As the airport expands, business and leisure travelers and private pilots would have the means to visit historic DeFuniak Springs.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	As the only airport in Walton County, many of the local residents will benefit from an expansion in industry opportunities. Increased economic development will directly benefit the unemployed and economically disadvantaged in Walton County. The range of individuals expected to be directly served by this is project is 200-400.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	North Walton County has experienced years of depressed economic conditions caused by years of decline or stagnation in local trade industries. These conditions led then-Governor Rick Scott to designate the area as a Rural Area of Economic Opportunity in 2017. Bringing new industries to the area will lead to higher wage jobs and increase the median household income of local residents.
f.	What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?
	There will be clawback provisions requiring the facility user to pay for performance metrics identified and not achieved.
