	In addition to academic classrooms, the renovation will include a culinary kitchen for vocational/job training, as well as personal cooking classes. The space will include a daily living classroom that will offer skills instruction to prepare students/individuals for living independently and job placement.

	In addition to daily educational programs, and in preparation for independent living, students will have instruction in daily living skil as well as vocational/job training.
