а.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested? To assist the elderly community in addition to those with poor mental health, poor physical health, or who are developmentally disabled by providing home accessibility services that keep them safe and in their homes.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Complete intake process to determine eligibility, assessment process at individual's homes, and planning process for completion of home accessibility services and the actual home accessibility.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Home accessibility services.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	Elderly persons, persons with poor mental health, persons with poor physical health, developmentally disabled persons, and physically disabled persons. Approximately 400 individuals with disabilities will be served.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	Improve physical health and prevent falls and other injury to seniors with disabilities living in their own homes. Number of home accessibility projects completed that improve mental health and promote independence of citizens with disabilities by allowing them to continue living in the community. Continued residence of citizens with disabilities in community, rather than a nursing home. Increase or improve economic activity. Savings to state of \$17,500,000 by diverting Medicaid long-term eligible individuals from nursing home placement. The annual savings to the state of \$87,500 per project participant X 200 of project participants is \$17,500,000; annual cost per project participant \$750,000/200=\$3,750 (annual average per person).
