	Construction of streetscape improvements on corridor.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Complete design and construction. Improve pedestrian and traffic accessibility from Cypress Road to US 1/Federal Highway.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Improve vehicular driving experience. Add missing sidewalks. Provide traffic controls. Improve roadway system in support of local bus system and future (proposed) bridge replacement. Improve lighting.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	Over 800 individuals, including students from elementary to high school, merchants, and residents of all ages.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	The redesigned roadway will improve pedestrian connectivity, improve drainage, improve street lighting, add bus shelters, and add landscape. Items will be measured using Local Area Planning reporting standards. Future replacement of an existing obsolete bridge will necessitate improving the approaches to the bridge to make sure drainage can be managed properly. The roadway re-work will address that deficiency as well.
