Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 456.031, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:
456.031 Requirement for instruction on domestic
violence.--

- (a) In lieu of completing a course as required in subsection (1), a licensee or certificateholder may complete a course in end-of-life care and palliative health care, if the licensee or certificateholder has completed an approved domestic violence course in the immediately preceding biennium.
- (b) In lieu of completing a course as required by subsection (1), a person licensed under chapter 466, who has completed an approved domestic-violence education course in the immediately preceding 2 years may complete a course approved by the Board of Dentistry.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides an alternative for certain required continuing dental education domestic-violence-course requirements.
