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- (2) Subject to a specific appropriation, the Department of Military Affairs is responsible for paying any premiums for life insurance coverage provided under this section.
- (3) The life insurance benefits provided under this section are supplemental to any other benefits provided to a member of the Florida National Guard.
- (4) The Department of Military Affairs shall report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives the number of life insurance policies provided and the amount of premiums paid under this section.
 - Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
