On or before July 1, 2006, the Department of Law Enforcement shall develop and implement a program to 11 12 conduct, at least biennially, a survey, using a sonar scanning 13 system that generates highly detailed two- and three-dimensional maps and charts, of the underwater areas of 14 each deepwater seaport in this state which serves cargo or 15 16 passenger vessels. 17 Section 2. The sum of \$1.5 million is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Law 18 Enforcement to administer this act. 19 Section 3.
