16	Section 1. Assessment of obsolete agricultural
17	equipment
18	(1) For purposes of assessment for ad valorem property
19	taxes, obsolete agricultural equipment shall be deemed to have
20	a market value no greater than its value for salvage. As used
21	in this section, the term "agricultural equipment" means any
22	equipment that qualifies for the sales tax exemption provided
23	in s. 212.08(3), Florida Statutes, wherever purchased.
24	Agricultural equipment shall be considered obsolete for
25	purposes of this section if it is no longer commonly used by
26	the taxpayer in agricultural production.
27	(2) Any taxpayer claiming the right of assessment for
28	ad valorem taxes under this section shall so state in a return
29	filed as provided by law, giving a brief description of the
30	equipment and its use. The property appraiser may require the
31	taxpayer to produce any additional information as necessary in

1	<u>order to establish the taxpayer's right to have such property</u>
2	classified as obsolete under this section for purposes of the
3	assessment.
4	Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
5	law.
