14	Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section
15	409.904, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
16	409.904 Optional payments for eligible personsThe
17	agency may make payments for medical assistance and related
18	services on behalf of the following persons who are determined
19	to be eligible subject to the income, assets, and categorical
20	eligibility tests set forth in federal and state law. Payment on
21	behalf of these Medicaid eligible persons is subject to the
22	availability of moneys and any limitations established by the

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A person who is in need of the services of a licensed 24 (3) 25 nursing facility, a licensed intermediate care facility for the developmentally disabled, or a state mental hospital, whose 26 27 income does not exceed 300 percent of the SSI income standard, and who meets the assets standards established under federal and 28 29 state law. In determining the person's responsibility for the cost of care, the following amounts must be deducted from the 30 31 person's income: The monthly personal allowance for residents which 32 (a) 33 shall be \$45 per month as set based on appropriations. Section 2. The sums of \$2,205,524 from the General Revenue 34 35 Fund and \$3,146,716 from the Medical Care Trust Fund are 36 appropriated to the Agency for Health Care Administration for 37 the 2006-2007 fiscal year for an increase in Medicaid 38 expenditures, and the sum of \$660,000 is appropriated from the 39 General Revenue Fund to the Department of Children and Family 40 Services for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for an increase to the personal care allowance. 41 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006. 42

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
