(1) The Florida Commission on Tourism, the 15 Florida Black Business Investment Board, Inc., and the Office 16 of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development shall jointly 18 establish a cooperative program to use African-American businesses to publicize the tourism advantages of this state. 19 The commission may contract with its direct-support 2.0 21 organization to administer the program. 22 (2) A committee shall be formed to enforce fairness in 23 African-American participation and use in the convention and tourism industry. The committee members shall be appointed by 2.4 the Florida Black Business Investment Board, Inc., and 2.5 approved by the Governor. 26 27 (3) The Florida Commission on Tourism, the Florida 2.8 Black Business Investment Board, Inc., and the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development shall consider the 29 use of price preferences of up to 10 percent, weighted 30 preference formulas, or other preferences for vendors that are
