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to achieve that goal, the Legislature intends to encourage training in lifesaving first aid and set standards for and encourage the use of automated external defibrillators.

(2) In order to ensure public health and safety:

(a) Any person or entity in possession of an automated

- 1. Properly maintain and test the device.
- 2. Provide training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and automated external defibrillator proficiency from the American Heart Association or the American Red Cross, or a substantially similar program from another provider, to any of its employees or agents who are reasonably expected to be potential users of the defibrillator. All persons who use an automated external defibrillator must obtain appropriate training, to include completion of a course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation or successful completion of a basic first aid course that includes cardiopulmonary resuscitation training, and demonstrated proficiency in the use of an automated external defibrillator.
- (b) Any person or entity in possession of an automated external defibrillator is encouraged to notify register with the local emergency medical services medical director of the existence and location of the automated external defibrillator.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
