- (e) Articulation agreements.
- (3) The Commissioner of Education, in consultation with the Chancellor of the State University System, shall establish an Articulation Coordinating Committee which shall report to the commissioner. The committee shall be a pre-K-20 advisory group that consists of members representing the State University System, the Community College System, public career and technical education, public pre-K-12 education, nonpublic education, and at least one member representing students.
