Subsection (1) of section 212.055, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 11 12 212.055 Discretionary sales surtaxes; legislative 13 intent; authorization and use of proceeds. -- It is the legislative intent that any authorization for imposition of a 14 discretionary sales surtax shall be published in the Florida 15 Statutes as a subsection of this section, irrespective of the 16 17 duration of the levy. Each enactment shall specify the types of counties authorized to levy; the rate or rates which may be 18 imposed; the maximum length of time the surtax may be imposed, 19 if any; the procedure which must be followed to secure voter 20 approval, if required; the purpose for which the proceeds may 21 22 be expended; and such other requirements as the Legislature 23 may provide. Taxable transactions and administrative procedures shall be as provided in s. 212.054. 2.4 (1) CHARTER COUNTY TRANSPORTATION TRANSIT SYSTEM 25 SURTAX.--26 27 (a) Each charter county that has which adopted a 2.8 charter prior to January 1, 1984, and each county the government of which is consolidated with that of one or more 29 municipalities, may levy a discretionary sales surtax, subject 30 to approval by a majority vote of the electorate of the county 31 1

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1 or by a charter amendment approved by a majority vote of the 2 electorate of the county. 3 (b) The rate shall be up to 1 percent. 4 (c) The proposal to adopt a discretionary sales surtax as provided in this subsection and to create a trust fund 5 б within the county accounts shall be placed on the ballot in 7 accordance with law at a time to be set at the discretion of 8 the governing body. (d) Proceeds from the surtax shall be applied to as 9 10 many or as few of the uses enumerated below in whatever combination the county commission deems appropriate: 11 12 1. Deposited by the county in the trust fund and shall 13 be used for the purposes of development, construction, equipment, maintenance, operation, supportive services, 14 including a countywide bus system, and related costs of a 15 fixed guideway rapid transit system; 16 17 2. Remitted by the governing body of the county to an 18 expressway, transit, or transportation authority created by law to be used, at the discretion of such authority, for the 19 development, construction, operation, or maintenance of roads 20 21 or bridges in the county, for the operation and maintenance of 22 a bus system, for the payment of principal and interest on 23 existing bonds issued for the construction of such roads or bridges, and, upon approval by the county commission, such 2.4 proceeds may be pledged for bonds issued to refinance existing 25 bonds or new bonds issued for the construction of such roads 26 27 or bridges; 28 3. Used by the charter county for the development, construction, operation, and maintenance of roads and bridges 29 in the county; for the expansion, operation, and maintenance 30 of bus and fixed guideway systems; and for the payment of 31

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1 principal and interest on bonds issued for the construction of 2 fixed guideway rapid transit systems, bus systems, roads, or bridges; and such proceeds may be pledged by the governing 3 body of the county for bonds issued to refinance existing 4 bonds or new bonds issued for the construction of such fixed 5 6 guideway rapid transit systems, bus systems, roads, or bridges 7 and no more than 25 percent used for nontransit uses; and 8 4. Used by the charter county for the planning, development, construction, operation, and maintenance of roads 9 10 and bridges in the county; for the planning, development, expansion, operation, and maintenance of bus and fixed 11 12 quideway systems; and for the payment of principal and 13 interest on bonds issued for the construction of fixed guideway rapid transit systems, bus systems, roads, or 14 bridges; and such proceeds may be pledged by the governing 15 body of the county for bonds issued to refinance existing 16 17 bonds or new bonds issued for the construction of such fixed 18 guideway rapid transit systems, bus systems, roads, or bridges. Pursuant to an interlocal agreement entered into 19 pursuant to chapter 163, the governing body of the charter 20 21 county may distribute proceeds from the tax to a municipality, 22 or an expressway or transportation authority created by law to 23 be expended for the purpose authorized by this paragraph.
