Subsection (8) is added to section 1013.64, 18 Florida Statutes, to read: 1013.64 Funds for comprehensive educational plant 19 needs; construction cost maximums for school district capital 20 projects. -- Allocations from the Public Education Capital 2.1 22 Outlay and Debt Service Trust Fund to the various boards for 23 capital outlay projects shall be determined as follows: (8)(a) Beginning with the 2007-2008 fiscal year, there 2.4 is established the Increased Utilization Program which shall 25 be funded as a part of the Public Education Capital Outlay and 26 Debt Service Trust Fund in an amount each year not to exceed 27 2.8 15 percent of the total funds appropriated under paragraph (3)(a). These funds shall be allocated by the commissioner to 29 any school district according to the following formula: Any 30 eligible school that increases its FTE facility capacity by at

least 20 percent as a result of using an alternative, 2 nontraditional calendar shall receive up to a maximum of \$250 per each FTE generated within the school. 3 4 (b) To be eliqible, a district school board must submit a resolution to the commissioner by August 1 of each 5 fiscal year, beginning August 1, 2007, of its intent to 6 7 participate in the Increased Utilization Program, listing each 8 of the schools eligible during the prior fiscal year. The information listed for each school must include the maximum 9 10 FTE capacity for the year as contained in the Florida Inventory of School Houses in the Office of Educational 11 12 Facilities and the increase attributable to the alternative, 13 nontraditional calendar. To be eligible, each individual school's FTE must exceed the maximum facility capacity during 14 the fiscal year by at least 20 percent. 15 (c) Each school district qualifying for funding under 16 this subsection may be paid up to \$250 per each FTE generated per eligible school for a maximum of 5 years if funds are 18 available. If funds are insufficient during any fiscal year, 19 the commissioner shall determine the pro rata amount. 2.0 21 (d) Funds received by a school district through the Increased Utilization Program shall be exempt from repayment 2.2 23 of any project outstanding pursuant to subsection (2). (e) All funds accruing to a school district under this 2.4 subsection shall be allocated to the schools generating the 2.5 increased capacity and shall be expended on needed projects as 26 2.7 recommended in a survey under the rules of the state board. 2.8 (f) Overcrowding of a school or double session does not apply. In addition, students may not be assigned to 29 instructional spaces contrary to the State Requirements for 30
