A bill to be entitled

An act relating to funding for delinquency prevention; amending s. 985.605, F.S.; providing for the Department of Juvenile Justice to allocate certain moneys to identified high-crime or high-delinquency areas; providing for the updating and distribution of data; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) is added to section 985.605, Florida Statutes, to read:

985.605 Prevention service program; monitoring; uniform performance measures.--

(3) The department shall allocate a proportionate share of all state and federal appropriations for delinquency prevention to high-crime or high-delinquency areas, identified by zip code and geographic area, and based on data obtained from crime information systems. The department shall update and distribute this data no later than May 1 of each year to the public via its website and to local juvenile justice councils and boards and to appropriate legislative committees.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
