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12	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
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14	Section 1. (1) DEFINITIONSAs used in this act:
15	(a) "Automatic renewal provision" means a provision under
16	which a service contract is renewed for a specified period if
17	the renewal causes the service contract to be in effect more
18	than 6 months after the day of the initiation of the service
19	contract. Such renewal is effective unless the consumer gives
20	notice to the seller of the consumer's intention to terminate
21	the service contract.
22	(b) "Consumer" means a person receiving service,
23	maintenance, or repair under a service contract. The term does
24	not include a person engaged in business for profit if the
25	person enters into the service contract as part of the person's
26	business activities.
27	(c) "Seller" means a person providing service,
28	maintenance, or repair under a service contract.
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29 SERVICE CONTRACTS WITH AUTOMATIC RENEWAL PROVISIONS. --(2) (a) 30 Any person, firm, partnership, association, or corporation engaged in commerce that sells, leases, or offers to 31 32 sell or lease any product or service to a consumer pursuant to a 33 service contract that automatically renews unless the consumer cancels the contract shall disclose the automatic renewal 34 35 provision clearly and conspicuously in the contract or contract 36 offer. 37 (b) Any person, firm, partnership, association, or corporation that sells or offers to sell any product or service 38 39 to a consumer pursuant to a service contract the term of which is a specified term of 12 months or more and that automatically 40 renews for a specified term of more than 1 month unless the 41 42 consumer cancels the contract shall notify the consumer in writing of the automatic renewal provision. Written notice shall 43 44 be provided to the consumer no less than 30 days and no more than 60 days before the cancellation deadline pursuant to the 45 automatic renewal provision. Such written notice shall disclose 46 47 clearly and conspicuously: That unless the consumer cancels the contract, the 48 1. 49 contract will automatically renew. 50 2. Methods by which the consumer may obtain details of the automatic renewal provision and cancellation procedure, whether 51 by contacting the seller at a specified telephone number or 52 address, by referring to the contract, or by any other method. 53 (c) A person, firm, partnership, association, or 54 corporation that fails to comply with the requirements of this 55 56 subsection is in violation of this subsection unless the person, Page 2 of 3

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57 firm, partnership, association, or corporation demonstrates 58 that: 1. As part of its routine business practice, it has 59 60 established and implemented written procedures to comply with 61 this section and enforces compliance with the procedures. 62 2. Any failure to comply with this subsection is the 63 result of error. 64 3. As part of its routine business practice, where an 65 error has caused the failure to comply with this subsection, it provides a full refund or credit for all amounts billed to or 66 67 paid by the consumer from the date of the renewal until the date 68 of the termination of the contract or the date of the subsequent notice of renewal, whichever occurs first. 69 70 (d) This subsection does not apply to banks, trust companies, savings and loan associations, savings banks, or 71 72 credit unions licensed or organized under the laws of any state 73 of the United States; any foreign bank maintaining a branch or 74 agency licensed under the laws of any state of the United 75 States; or any subsidiary or affiliate thereof. 76 (e) A violation of this subsection renders the automatic 77 renewal provision void and unenforceable. 78 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.

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
