to provide financial support to verified trauma centers to ensure the availability and accessibility of trauma services throughout the state. Funds deposited into the Administrative Trust Fund under this section shall be allocated as follows:

- (a) Twenty-five percent shall be allocated equally among all Level I, Level II, and pediatric trauma centers in recognition of readiness costs for maintaining trauma services.
- Twenty-five percent shall be allocated among Level I, (b) Level II, and pediatric trauma centers based on each center's



relative volume of trauma cases as reported in the Department of
Health Trauma Registry.
(c) Twenty-five percent shall be allocated for emergency
medical services.
(d) Twenty-five percent shall be allocated for rural
emergency medical services.
