Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 943.10, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

943.10 Definitions; ss. 943.085-943.255.--The following words and phrases as used in ss. 943.085-943.255 are defined as follows:

"Correctional officer" means any person who is (2) appointed or employed full time by the state or any political subdivision thereof, or by any private entity contracting which has contracted with the state or political subdivision county, and whose primary responsibility is the supervision, protection, care, custody, and control, or investigation, of inmates within a correctional institution. The term also includes any person employed full time by the state as institutional security personnel as defined in s. 916.106.; however, The term "correctional officer" does not include any secretarial, clerical, or professionally trained personnel.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
