Section 11. Subsection (5) is added to section 1006.25, Florida Statutes, to read:

1006.25 School buses.--School buses shall be defined and meet specifications as follows:

- (5) SPONSORSHIP.--
- (a) A school bus may be sponsored according to district school board policies that provide for private sponsorships as follows:
- 1. Any individual or business entity may sponsor a school bus by paying a fee to be set by the district school board. Up to 5 percent of the fees collected may be used to pay the cost of an advertising agent involved in the sponsorship. The

- remaining funds shall be used by the district school board for school transportation purposes.
- 2. There may be only one business entity sponsor per school bus. Individual sponsorships or cosponsorships shall be permitted.
- (b) The design, placement, and size of signage on the exterior of a school bus acknowledging the sponsor of the school bus shall be prescribed by rule of the State Board of Education.
