A bill to be entitled

An act relating to public postsecondary education; creating a study committee to investigate the feasibility of, and the process for, establishing a research university; providing for the appointment of study committee members; specifying responsibilities and requiring presentation of findings and recommendations; providing for termination; providing an appropriation; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) There is created a study committee to investigate the feasibility of, and the process for, establishing a new university in the State University System with a strong emphasis on advanced scientific and technological research. Initially, the university shall offer postgraduate studies and attract only the most academically gifted students.

(2) The study committee shall be composed of the following members:

(a) Four members of the Board of Governors of the State University System appointed by the Governor.

(b) Two individuals with expertise in scientific and technological research appointed by the Governor.

(c) Two individuals with expertise in educational finance, one each appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

(3) The responsibilities of the study committee include, but are not limited to, the responsibility to:

(a) Study and make visitations to some of the nation's top-ranked research universities, such as the Georgia Institute of Technology, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and the California Institute of Technology, to determine how the missions of such institutions are accomplished.

- (b) Develop a plan and process for establishing a new university in the State University System that:
- 1. Is committed to educating future leaders in science and technology, initially at the postgraduate level.
- 2. Integrates research with education with a focus on producing innovation that will benefit society, help drive economic growth, and improve human life on a global scale.
- 3. Investigates and addresses the challenges in science and technology in an interdisciplinary approach.
- 4. Attracts students with high academic qualifications and capabilities.
- (c) Develop a cost analysis and financial strategy for establishing a leading research university.
- (d) Establish criteria for naming opportunities for the solicitation of private donors.
- (4) The study committee shall present findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Board of Governors of the State University System by January 31, 2010, and shall terminate after such presentation.
- Section 2. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Governors of the State University System for fiscal year 2009-2010 to implement the provisions of this act.
