## House Memorial A memorial to the Congress of the United States, petitioning that a convention be called pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution to consider amending the United States Constitution to limit the terms of members of the Congress of the United States to twelve years; providing that the purview of such convention be limited strictly to the consideration of this amendment; providing that this application to the Congress be a continuing application until the convention herein applied for is convened. Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: That pursuant to Article V of the Constitution of the United States, the Legislature of the State of Florida does hereby apply to the Congress of the United States for a convention to consider the following amendment to the United States Constitution: Section 1. No person may appear on the ballot for reelection to the office of Representative or Senator who, by the end of the current term of office will have served or, but for resignation, would have served, in that office for twelve consecutive years. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the purview of any convention called by the Congress pursuant to this memorial be strictly limited to the consideration of an amendment of the nature as herein proposed.
