(3)(a) If a natural person violates s. 626.9541(1)(1), the offense known as "twisting," or violates s. 626.9541(1)(aa), the offense known as "churning," the person commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, and an administrative fine not greater than \$5,000 shall be imposed for each nonwillful violation or an administrative fine not greater than \$40,000 shall be imposed for each willful violation.
