13	320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

15	(69) FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE LICENSE PLATES
16	(a)1. The department shall develop a Fraternal Order of
17	Police license plate as provided in this section. The plate must
18	bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word
19	"Florida" must appear at the top of the plate and the words
20	"Fraternal Order of Police" must appear at the bottom of the

22	2. The department may issue the plate only to an applicant

The word "Florida" 47 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Support 48 Autism Programs" must appear at the bottom of the plate. 49 (b) The proceeds from the license plate annual use fee 50 shall be distributed to Achievement and Rehabilitation Centers, 51 Inc., to fund service programs for autism and related 52 disabilities throughout the state and to operate and establish 53 programs to support individuals with autism and related 54 disabilities through direct services, evaluation, training, and 55 awareness.
