A bill to be entitled

An act relating to local governmental powers; amending s. 125.01, F.S.; prohibiting a county from requiring a private property owner to expend funds to enhance certain services or functions provided by local governments which benefit the general public at the expense of the property owner; amending s. 166.021, F.S.; prohibiting a municipality from requiring a private property owner to expend funds to enhance certain services or functions provided by local governments which benefit the general public at the expense of the property owner; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (8) is added to section 125.01, Florida Statutes, to read:

125.01 Powers and duties.-

(8) The legislative and governing body of a county may not enforce or cause to be enforced, a county code or ordinance that requires a private property owner to expend funds or take action to expend funds to enhance the services or functions provided by local governments, such as protection of the public health, safety, and welfare, and which provide a benefit to the general public at the expense of the private property owner.

Section 2. Present subsection (10) of section 166.021, Florida Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (11), and a new subsection (10) is added to that section, to read:

(10) The legislative and governing body of a municipality may not enforce or cause to be enforced a municipal code or ordinance that requires a private property owner to expend funds or take action to expend funds to enhance the services or functions provided by local governments, such as protection of the public health, safety, and welfare, and which provide a benefit to the general public at the expense of the private property owner.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
