A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Florida National Guard; requiring the Florida National Guard, in conjunction with the Division of Community Colleges and the community colleges of the state, to develop a plan to provide educational opportunities to enlisted members of the Florida National Guard; requiring that the plan be submitted to the Governor and Legislature by a certain date; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Florida National Guard is a crucial component of the Florida Emergency Response System in times of local and statewide national disasters, civil disobedience, and other catastrophic events and is a key component of the United States Armed Forces, subject to be called upon for active federal duty, including deployment for the War on Terrorism and other missions in defense of the interests of the United States, and

WHEREAS, enlisted personnel in grades E-1 through E-9 constitute approximately 80 percent of the strength of the Florida National Guard, a large percentage of whom have educational deficits, primarily in grades E-1 through E-4, which can limit their performance capabilities, and

WHEREAS, collegiate-quality educational services that address basic functional and intellectual deficits in areas such as reading, writing, mathematics, social and behavioral sciences, cultural awareness, and natural sciences would increase the value of enlisted personnel to the Florida National Guard by preparing them for progressively greater responsibilities, and

WHEREAS, the community colleges of this state have demonstrated their capabilities to respond expeditiously and effectively to address unique training and education needs of their students through customized associated degree programs, and

WHEREAS, a formalized partnership between the Florida
National Guard and the Division of Community Colleges of the
Department of Education and its statewide network of community
colleges dedicated to the improvement of the quality of the
noncommissioned ranks by the systematic reduction of basic
functional and intellectual deficits and the elevation of
educational attainment to the associate degree level would
strengthen the capabilities of the Florida National Guard, NOW
THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The commanding general of the Florida

National Guard, in conjunction with the Division of Community

Colleges of the Department of Education and the community

colleges of this state, shall develop a plan to implement a

program that provides educational opportunities for enlisted

members of the Florida National Guard. The program shall be

designed to increase the performance capabilities of members of
the Florida National Guard.

(2) The plan shall be submitted to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by November 1, 2009.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
