Senator Bennett moved the following:

## Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

3 Delete lines 14 - 36 4 and insert:

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125.01045 Prohibition of collection of fees for firstresponder services.-

(1) As residents are currently taxed or assessed for essential government services, a county may not seek reimbursement from a resident of that county for any costs or expenses that may be incurred for services provided by a first responder, including costs or expenses related to personnel, supplies, motor vehicles, or equipment in response to a motor



vehicle accident, except for transportation and treatment provided by ambulance services licensed pursuant to s. 401.23(5).

(2) As used in this section, the term "first responder" means a law enforcement officer as defined in s. 943.10, a firefighter as defined in s. 633.30, or an emergency medical technician or paramedic as defined in s. 401.23 who is employed by the state or a local government. A volunteer law enforcement officer, firefighter, or emergency medical technician or paramedic engaged by the state or a local government is also considered a first responder of the state or local government for purposes of this section.

Section 2. Section 166.0446, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

166.0446 Prohibition of collection of fees for firstresponder services.-

(1) A municipality may not seek reimbursement from a resident of that municipality for any costs or expenses that may be incurred for
