An act relating to public K-12 educational
instruction; amending s. 1003.46, F.S., relating to
health education; deleting provisions that require
schools to teach abstinence from sexual activity

sexuality; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 1003.46, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 1003.46 Health education; instruction in acquired immune deficiency syndrome.—
- (2) Throughout instruction in acquired immune deficiency syndrome, sexually transmitted diseases, or health education, when such instruction and course material contains instruction in human sexuality, a school shall:
- (a) Teach abstinence from sexual activity outside of marriage as the expected standard for all school-age students while teaching the benefits of monogamous heterosexual marriage.
- (a) (b) Emphasize that abstinence from sexual activity is a certain way to avoid out-of-wedlock pregnancy, sexually transmitted diseases, including acquired immune deficiency syndrome, and other associated health problems.
- (b) (e) Teach that each student has the power to control personal behavior and encourage students to base actions on reasoning, self-esteem, and respect for others.
