1006.25 School buses.--School buses shall be defined and meet specifications as follows:

- (5) SPONSORSHIP.--
- (a) A school bus may be sponsored according to district school board policies that provide for private sponsorships as follows:
- 1. Any individual or business entity may sponsor a school bus by paying a fee to be set by the district school board. Up to 5 percent of the fees collected may be used to pay the cost of an advertising agent involved in the sponsorship. The 402201
