Section 2. Subsection (2) of section 409.914, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

409.914 Assistance for the uninsured.-

Families, shall develop a Medicaid buy-in program individuals eligible for Medicaid under s. 409.904(10). The Agency for Persons with Disabilities is responsible for the programmatic management of the Medicaid buy-in program, pursuant to s. 20.197(3).

- (b) Participants in the Medicaid buy-in program shall be charged a premium based on a sliding scale once the participant's earned income exceeds 100 percent of the federal poverty level. Assets excluded, in addition to those excluded under the supplemental security income program, are as follows: cash assets in the amount of \$10,000 for a single individual and \$15,000 for a couple; any retirement account recognized by the Internal Revenue Service; and a second vehicle for a couple.
- (c) The Agency for Persons with Disabilities shall adopt by rule procedures to administer the Medicaid buy-in program authorized in this subsection, including Medicaid buy-in program eligibility and premiums.

The agency shall seek federal statutory or regulatory reforms to establish a Medicaid buy-in program to provide medical assistance to persons ineligible for Medicaid because of current income and categorical restrictions. The agency shall use funds provided by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation to assist in developing the buy-in program, including, but not limited to, the determination of eligibility and service coverages; cost sharing requirements; managed care provisions; changes needed to the Medicaid program's claims processing, utilization control, cost control, case management, and provider enrollment systems to operate a buy-in program.

(b) The agency shall seek federal authorization and



financial support for a buy-in program that provides federally supported medical assistance coverage for persons with incomes up to 250 percent of the federal poverty level. The agency shall not implement the Medicaid buy-in program until it has received necessary federal authorization and financial participation and state appropriations.

Section 3. The Agency for Health Care Administration shall seek amendments to the Medicaid state plan and Medicaid waivers serving persons with disabilities to provide that persons who are eligible for Medicaid under a Medicaid buy-in program authorized under s. 409.904(10) and s. 409.914(2), Florida Statutes, may be eligible for services under waivers if they otherwise meet the level of care qualifications for services under the waiver.

Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
