plate, and the words "Let's Go Surfing" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

- (b) The license plate annual use fees shall be distributed to East Coast Surfing Hall of Fame and Museum, Inc., to fund activities, programs, and projects to promote Florida's surfing-related tourism, preserve Florida's surfing history and heritage, preserve Florida's surf and shores, and honor lifeguards who patrol Florida's surf and shores to protect beach-goers, surfers, and others. East Coast Surfing Hall of Fame and Museum, Inc., may retain all revenue from the annual use fees until all startup costs for developing and establishing the plate have been recovered. Thereafter, up to 10 percent of the annual use fee revenue may be used for administration, promotion, and marketing of the plate, including the annual audit and compliance affidavit costs.
 - (70) FLORIDA HORSE PARK LICENSE PLATES. --
- (a) The department shall develop a Florida Horse Park
 license plate as provided in this section. The plate must bear
 the colors and design approved by the department. The word
 "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words
 "Discover Florida's Horses" must appear at the bottom of the
 plate.
- (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Florida Agriculture Center and Horse Park Authority created by s. 570.952, which shall retain all proceeds until all startup costs for developing and establishing the plate have been recovered. Thereafter, the proceeds shall be used as follows:
 - 1. A maximum of 5 percent of the proceeds from the annual

use fees may be used for the administration of the Florida Horse Park license plate program.

- 2. A maximum of 5 percent of the proceeds may be used to promote and market the license plate.
- 3. The remaining proceeds shall be used by the authority to promote the Florida Agriculture Center and Horse Park located in Marion County; to support continued development of the park, including the construction of additional educational facilities, barns, and other structures; to provide improvements to the existing infrastructure at the park; and to provide for operational expenses of the Florida Agriculture Center and Horse Park.
 - Section 4. This act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
