32 (c) Show each customer how to use suitable physical aids,
33 such as handrails and floor markings, to maintain proper
34 exposure distances recommended by the manufacturer.

35 (d) Use a timer on each tanning device which is accurate
36 for any selected time interval to plus or minus 10 percent.

37 (e) Limit each customer to the maximum exposure time38 recommended by the manufacturer of the tanning device.

39 (f) Maintain the interior temperature of the tanning 40 facility below 100 °F.

Each time a person uses a tanning facility or executes 41 (q) 42 or renews a contract to use a tanning facility, have the person sign a written statement acknowledging that he or she has read 43 44 and understands the warnings before using the device and that he 45 or she agrees to use the protective eyewear. Before a minor is 46 allowed to use the device, the minor's parent or legal guardian 47 must sign a written statement acknowledging that he or she has read and understands the warnings and that the minor agrees to 48 49 use protective eyewear.

50 (h) Display its license in a public area of the tanning 51 facility.

(i) Report any injury or any complaint of injury to the department on forms prescribed by the department and provide a copy of the report to the complainant. The department shall send to the federal Food and Drug Administration a copy of any report of an injury occurring in a tanning facility.
