Section 1. Paintball guns and paintball markers.-

(1) As used in this section, the term "paintball gun" or "paintball marker" means a device designed and manufactured to propel, by gas or air, an encapsulated gelatin paintball.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3), a person may not carry a paintball gun or paintball marker in a vehicle on a highway unless:

(a) The paintball gun or marker is disassembled so that the propellant canister is separate from the rest of the device and the device contains no paintballs; or

(b) The propellant canister contains no propellant and the device contains no paintballs.
