(2) As used in this act, the term "novelty lighter" means a mechanical device that uses a flammable gas or liquid or an electrical current to commonly ignite cigarettes, cigars, or pipes and that resembles any item that is typically appealing to children 10 years of age or younger, including, but not limited to, a lighter that resembles a cartoon character, animal, toy, gun, watch, musical instrument, vehicle, food, or beverage, or

that plays sounds or musical notes or displays flashing lights or other visual effects.

(3) This act does not apply to lighters manufactured before January 1, 1980.
