(f) "Sober house-transitional living home" means an unlicensed community residential home that provides a peer supported and managed alcohol and drug-free living environment for up to six unrelated residents who are recovering from substance abuse and are actively participating in licensed substance abuse treatment, nonlicensed peer-support services, or who are in transition back to the community from residential treatment programs or incarceration. The homes are supervised by a house manager who ensures that the sober living environment

offers structure and strong peer support. Residents pay weekly or monthly rent and other living expenses associated with the operation of the home while working, attending treatment, or attending school during the day and engaging in recovery activities in the evenings. A sober house-transitional living home that is established on or after July 1, 2010, may not operate within 1,000 feet of another such home.
